



FRENCH OAK PANELING

Perhaps best loved for the nuance it adds to French wines, we appreciate the warm golden hue of our sustainably harvested old-growth French Oak. This hardwood has low porosity, high density, and high tannin content. While not reclaimed, the French have managed their forests such that each felled tree is replaced with a seedling. Our oak is PEFC certified (the worldwide equivalent to FSC certified) to help maintain healthy, old growth forests for generations to come.

Our paneling has been kiln dried for stability and back planed to thickness for straightforward installation. We stock square-edge widths between 6” and 12” (in 1” increments), which can be single- or mixed-width, depending on your desired aesthetic. This material can also be milled with a ship lap or tongue and groove profile. If these stock options aren’t exactly what you were looking for, we are happy to mill to your custom specifications.
