

Stutzman Barn Frame

Structure:

- Historic barn frame
- Dutch style: interior posts run vertically to the mid rafter plate
- Bent layout allows for the addition of second story lofts or rooms with minimal structural timbers required
- Hand hewn timbers are predominantly white oak

Measurements:

- 42'(w) x 78'2"(l)
- 2 levels
- Hand-hewn timber posts are 9"(w) x 16"(d) x 16'(t)
- Bent section layout is 19' – 16' - 14' – 12' – 18'

Condition:

- Sound and in good condition

History:

- Built circa 1820's
- Original location – Holmes County, Ohio
- Original use – Barn
